ROTARY "DANCERS" NEEDED

How do we **admit a new member?**
 The **Proposer** (any Denville Rotarian in good standing) completes Section A of the R.I. Membership Proposal Form (MPF) and gives it to the Secretary. The **Secretary** gives the MPF to the Club President, who calls a special Board meeting.
 The **Board** approves the MPF and the Secretary informs the Proposer and notifies the Past President's group. A **member of the Past President's** group meets with the proposed new member and (a) provides Rotary information, (b) gets the prospective member's signature in Section B of the MPF, and (c) returns the completed MPF to the Secretary. The **Secretary** sends out the "seven-day letter" to all members in good standing. Assuming no adverse comment to the "seven day letter" the new member pays fees and dues.
 The **President** schedules induction of new member.
